June will be a month of youth and Europe in Opole!

We would like to invite you to join our almostsummer volunteering adventure.

Youth energy, spirit of the culture's mixture, kids discovering the world and enjoying colorful meeting with diversity, spreading the European values - that is our plan for this month!





WHAT WE WILL DO?

During the project "Euroville - International Youth Month" we will:

- work together on the biggest annual youth event in Opolskie - Regional Youth Congress, organizing i.a. "diversity zone", workshops and international evening party,
- build the Euroville European Village and run the workshops for children and youth from Opolskie Region,
- prepare presentations about the cultural diversity, our countries, international cooperation during the local events and workshops in schools,
- cooperate with 10 volunteers from different countries from all the Europe.

WHAT IS THE PLAN?

During the project, volunteers will be working on different tasks, partially in a group, partially in the small groups and indivitually, cooperating with our team and support of our mentors - approximately 6 hours/day, 5 days a week.

There will be partially work during the weekends (f.ex. during the youth congress), but you will get the free days during the week instead. Additionally, you will get 2 free days/month, planned in the end of the project.



WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for people from EU and partner countries who are:

- under 30 years old,
- want to take up the challenge of 1-month volunteering in Poland,
- speak English on a communicative level,
- are motivated, creative and ready to work in a group,
- are ready to work with kids and youth,
- are interested in the topics of youth participation, culture diversity, European values.

WHAT WE PROVIDE?

As part of the project, we will provide:

- active month full of creative work, culture, European values and youth,
- accomodation in double/triple/quadruple rooms in a hostel/student dorm in Opole and/or venue of activities,
- pocket money in the amount of 120 EUR,
- funds for meals in the amount of 500 PLN + full board during the congress,
- access to full necessary equipment,
- reimbursement of travel costs for the project and return,
- free time for sightseeing.



OPOLE AND OPOLSKIE REGION

Opole, the capital of the Opolskie voivodship, is a medium sized city of 125,000 and coverings a total area of 96 km2. It is located in the southwestern part of Poland, on the river Oder. Located in Silesia Region, close to the Czech border, with huge German minority and open for Europe, Opolskie Region is a place of diversity and dialog. Opole is primarily known as the home of the National Festival of Polish Songs, held in June, but it combines culture, education, tourism and business. It is small, yet enchanting, with numerous canals and green spaces adding to its charm.
